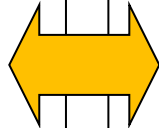

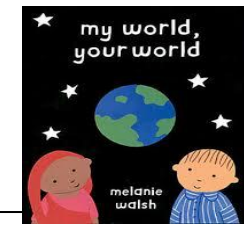
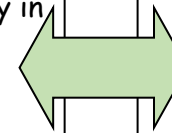
Personal, Social & Emotional Development

- Name and discuss different feelings
- Understand the importance of tooth brushing to maintain healthy teeth
- Parachute games
- Learn about people who help us to stay safe and healthy
- Learn to follow our class rules



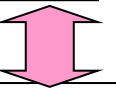
Communication and Language

- Following instructions at tidy up time
- Understanding positional language through role play and construction
- Learn how to listen carefully
- Learn new vocabulary based on class texts and use it in play
- Practise retelling familiar stories.
- Learn nursery rhymes and songs
- Talk about non-fiction texts based on people who help us
- Develop social phrases as they play in the role play areas



Physical Development

- Using playground climbing and balancing equipment
- Obstacle courses
- Ball games
- Large and small mark making activities inside and outside
- Practise holding a pencil with an effective tripod grip
- Handwriting practice
- Getting dressed independently and washing hands
- Pretend cooking in the mud kitchen
- Making sandwiches



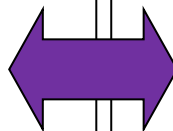

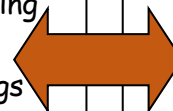
Literacy

- Learn letter sounds with our phonics program Read Write Inc
- Blend sounds and read simple words
- Learn to continue a rhyming string
- Give meaning to marks as they draw
- Write a list of ingredients
- Write a speech bubble
- Write their name and other labels



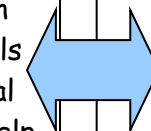
Mathematics

- Recognising numbers to 5
- Counting objects accurately
- Use Numicon as an aid to counting
- Use Numberblocks to consolidate understanding of number
- Number games and songs
- Matching, sorting socks, using vocabulary 'same' and 'different'
- Compare amounts, using the words 'more' and 'less'
